AUGUSTA PAETH

Dies at Pasch Home in Groton on Thursday, April 25.

Mrs. Augusta Paeth passed away at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Gus Pasch, in Groton, on Thursday, April 25, 1918, after an illness which was of long duration and throughout which she suffered a great deal. Funeral services occurred from the Pasch home on Saturday afternoon at one o'clock, Mr. and Mrs. Pasch and Mr. and Mrs. Ferd Paeth accompanying the remains to Wilton, Wis., where interment occurred on Monday following services at that place. The services in Groton were in charge of Rev. A. Senne.

Augusta Paeth, nee Paeth, was born July 6, 1846, in the Village Dagorese, Pommern, Germany. She was baptised and confirmed there in the Lutheran church. She was married at the same place to August Paeth. This union was blessed with two children, both dying, however, in infancy.

In 1872 Mr. and Mrs. Paeth came to America, New York, Long Island, remaining there for seven years and then moved to Wilton, Wis. They farmed there until 1904, when her husband, August Paeth, died. During the last two years Augusta Paeth lived with her relatives, part of the time in Wisconsin and the last year with her sister, Mrs. G. Pasch here in Groton.

She died April 25 at an age of 71 years, 7 months and 19 days.

Mrs. Augusta Paeth was a sister of Mrs. Gus Pasch and Mr. Ferdinand Paeth. She was a good kind lady with a splendid disposition and had gained many friends during her short stay in Groton.
