Martha Paetznick, 85, Groton, died at St. Luke's Midland Regional Medical Center, Aberdeen, Tuesday, Nov. 23, 1993.

The funeral was at St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Groton, Saturday, Nov. 27, 1993, with the Rev. John Werner officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery, with Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel in charge of arrangements.
