Ernest F. Pasch

Services for Ernest F. Pasch, 85, were held Saturday, Feb. 24 at the local St. John Lutheran Church. He died Wednesday in Flandreau at Riverview Manor.

The Rev. Gordon Buchholz officiated and burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery under the direction of the Ackerson Funeral Home.

Music was furnished by a duet, Mr. and Mrs. Alfred Sueltz, accompanied by Mrs. Eugene Neuman, organist.

Mr. Pasch was born September 10, 1882, the son of Gustav and Bertha Pasch, at Groton. He was baptized at Trinity Lutheran Church in James in 1882. He was confirmed in 1896. Mr. Pasch was raised and educated in Groton and started farming in the Groton area and was married to Edna Schlick on Feb. 23, 1910 and the couple continued to farm until 1942 when they moved into Groton. Mrs. Pasch died in October of 1961. He continued to live in Groton until September, 1967 when he entered Riverview Manor in Flandreau. He was a member of St. John Lutheran Church in Groton.

Survivors include two sons, Ervin, Flandreau; and Walter, Groton; seven grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, two brothers and two sisters.
