Services have been held at Miles City, Mont., for Pearly W. Pengray, 65, Mobridge resident and engineer on the Milwaukee Railroad, who died there last Thursday while visiting friends. Rites were conducted by the Rev. John B. Fitz at the chapel of the Graves Funeral Home and burial was at Mountain View, Calif.

Mr. and Mrs. Pengray had stopped overnight with Mr. and Mrs. Paul Byington when he suffered the fatal heart attack. They were en route to Mobridge from Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, where they recently had purchased a home and planned to live following his retirement.
