Mrs. Fanny Perrin

Mrs. Fanny P. Perrin, 83, of 1019 S. Jay St., Aberdeen, died Monday at St. Luke's hospital.

Services will be 2:00 p. m., Thursday at the Huebel Chapel in Aberdeen, with the Rev. J. Harley Thompson of the First Methodist church officiating. Burial will be in the Groton Union cemetery.

Mrs. Perrin was born March 10, 1877, in Brighton, Mich., and at an early age she came with her parents to Dakota Territory. They homesteaded at Rose, which then was located near Brentford.

She taught school at Mt. Horeb, Wis., and at Houghton. She married Frederick Perrin in 1910 in Aberdeen and they made their home on his farm near Ferney. They lived there until 1932 when they moved to Hartford Beach on Big Stone lake. In 1952 they came to Aberdeen. Mr. Perrin died in 1953.

Survivors include one sister, Mrs. Minerva Jenkins, Black Earth, Wis., and many nieces and nephews, including E. A. Smith, Aberdeen.
