

## EDWARD J. PFEIFER DIES

We glean the following from this morning's American:

The funeral of Edward J. Pfeifer will be held Friday at 11 a. m. in the Church at James and the interment will be made at Groton. Mr. Pfeifer was one of the pioneers and prominent farmers of the county. It was upon his farm, the old Yorkville place near Groton, that was standing till this fall, the oldest house in the county, an old log hut erected in an early day. Mr. Pfeifer was born in Germany, April 14, 1843, and came to Watertown, Wis., when a boy of 9 years. In 1888 he came to Groton and bought the farm where he lived till his death, Tuesday afternoon at 3:30. He is survived by the following children, all but one of whom live near the home place: Edward, Arthur, Charles, William, Max, Mrs. August Semrich of Watertown, Wis., Mrs. Frank Wagoner of James, and Mrs. John C. Quincer of Groton.
