Truck Mishap Injuries Fatal to Groton Man

Allan Pigors, 27, son of Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Pigors, Andover, passed away at 9:45 a. m., Monday, at St. Lukes' Hospital in Aberdeen, where he was in critical condition following a truck accident which occurred early Friday morning.

According to a preliminary report given by the sheriff, Allan was running to catch a truck driven by his brother, James, with whom he farms, and in trying to catch hold of the vehicle, fell beneath the wheels. The truck, half loaded with shelled corn, passed over the trunk of the man's body. The mishap occurred on highway No. 37, in the city limits here at about 1:00 a. m., Friday.

The driver told officers he did not see his brother.

Survivors include his wife, a son, his parents, two brothers and a sister.

Funeral services will be at the local St. John's Lutheran church, Friday, at 2:00 p. m., with the Rev. R. M. Grundmeier officiating. Burial will be in the Lutheran cemetery at Fernelley. Paetznick Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
