

# Ewald (Abe) Pigors 12-21-88

FERNEY - The funeral for Ewald (Abe) Pigors, 75, Ferney, was held Monday at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Ferney. The Rev. John Dawson officiated.

Burial was in the Ferney Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton.

He died Thursday, Dec. 15, 1988, at Pigors Lake near Ferney.

He served in the Civilian Conservation Corps for several years during the 1930s.

He married JoAnn S. Van De Brake in Groton June 11, 1944.

He served as an elder and chairman of the congregation and was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Ferney. He was a Bible class teacher and served as a member of the building committee for the new church in Ferney. He also served on the East Hanson Town-

He was preceded in death by his parents, one son, five brothers and one sister.
