## Mrs. Floyd Potter

Mrs. Floyd (Daisey) Potter, 83, died Wednesday at the Bethesda Nursing Home in Webster.

Funeral services were held at 2 p. m., Saturday, Dec. 10, at the Andover Methodist Church. The Rev. James Vos of Conde officiated and burial was in the Andover cemetery.

Music was provided by Mrs. James Vos, soloist, accompanied by Mrs. James McKane Sr., organist.

Pall bearers were James DeBilzan, R. C. Keup, Robert Anderson, Gordon Flemmer, Henry Wall and Clarence Hannon.

Mrs. Potter was born Feb 20, 1883, and was the first child born in Andover township. She attended high school in Minneapolis and was employed by the E. C. Toy Store in Andover before her marriage to Floyd Potter at Andover, Dec. 6, 1905. The couple farmed in north Andover township until 1933. Later they moved to Andover and operated a dry goods and grocery store. She retired in 1949. She had been a resident of the Bethesda Nursing Home since October 1960.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. Roland (Helen) Brooks, Groton; two sons, Arthur, Pierpont; and Robert, Milwaukee, Ore.; 15 grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband in 1946 and one son.
