Services for Mrs. Ella Prestegard, 64, former Aberdeen resident who died Friday at Austin, Minn., were held at 1:00 p. m., Tuesday, Dec. 9, at the First Baptist Church in Aberdeen with the Rev. Harold E. Salem officiating. Burial was in Groton cemetery.
