Services for Anton Prestwick, 91, of 22 10th Ave. SE, Aberdeen, were held at 11 a. m., Monday, June 6 at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Aberdeen with Rev. O. M. Simundson officiating.

Burial was at Summit Monday afternoon. He passed away Thursday at St. Luke's Hospital.

Mr. Prestwick was born at Trondhjem, Norway, on Aug. 26, 1874, and came to the United States as a young man. He served as superintendent of schools in Roberts County, and was for a time publisher of a Sisseton newspaper. He served for many years as a food and drug inspector for the state. He retired at age 86.

He was a member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church, the Masonic Lodge, Scottish Rite and Yelduz Shrine.

His first wife preceded him in death in 1939. In 1944 he married Tena Swenson in Aberdeen. She preceded him in death in 1965.
