## Last Rites Held Tuesday for Roy B. Pulfrey, 64

Services were held in the Paetznick Funeral Home in Groton on Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, for Roy B. Pulfrey, 64-year-old Claremont farmer, who died on Thursday, June 24, of a cerebral hemorrhage after an extended illness. The Rev. J. D. Hollister officiated and burial was made in the Groton union cemetery.

Mr. Pulfrey was born December 31, 1883, in Rush township, Ill., and married Lulu Schuller on January 18, 1908. He had been a resident of the Claremont vicinity for 49 years.
