H. A. Raitz Interred at Fountain City, Wis.

Funeral services were conducted at Fountain City, Wis., for Henry A. Raitz, former Groton man, who died in Cincinnati, Ohio., on July 7th, from acute heart attacks. He was well known in Groton, having resided here several years, during which he was employed as engineer at the city power plant.

While he had been away from Groton for almost twenty years, he kept in close touch with his friends here and made one of his periodic visits here last spring, apparently in the best of health and spirits. News of his death was therefore received by his friends here with surprise and sincere regrets.

He was a native of Wisconsin, born at Waumndee on August 24, 1873, and would thus have been 68 years old had he survived until the 24th of next month. He was married to Miss Minnie C. Voegel on December 18, 1896, who preceded him in death September 17, 1934.

Survivors are his son, Dr. Roswell E. Raitz, a practising physician of Cincinnati and a granddaughter, Marianne, a brother, Edward, of Yakima, Washington, two sisters, Mrs. Della Christ, residing in California and Mrs. Maybelle Wood, Eau Galle, Wis.

He was active up to the time of his death as operating engineer in the main pumping station at Cincinnati. He was a Scottish Rite Mason and a member of the Shrine and also of the Modern Woodmen of America and had been president of the Cincinnati chapter of the National Association of Power Engineers.
