# Gladys F. Riedinger, 96

The funeral for Gladys F. Riedinger, 96, Claremont, was held at the United Methodist Church in Claremont September 25, 1992. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton. She died Wednesday, Sept. 23, 1992, at the Colonial Manor in Groton.

Gladys Bibler was born June 25, 1896, to Sam and Lillian (Snyder) Bibler at Chicago. She lived in Bringham, Ind., and Buckingham, Ill., where she attended grade school. She attended Normal College for one year and received a teaching certificate. She taught school for 16 years and then worked in a bank and in several department stores doing bookkeeping.

She married Art Riedinger October 8, 1936, at Champaign, Ill. They lived in St. Louis and then moved to the Langford area and farmed. They lived in California for 25 years. She and her stepson moved to Claremont in 1973 and she had resided at the Colonial Manor since 1985.
