✓ **AUGUSTA W. RIEMER**

**Passes Away at Home in Groton on
Friday Afternoon.**

Mrs. Augusta W. Riemer passed away at her home in Groton, as the result of diabetes, Friday evening at 6 o'clock. She had been up and around the day preceding her death, having prepared her own meals. Several of her neighbors and friends had called on her and they had expressed a desire to stay with her through the night.

This she did not wish and she remained alone. The next morning a neighbor called and found her lying on the kitchen floor in a semi-conscious condition. She was then accorded the best of care, but she didn't rally after that passing away at 6 o'clock.

Augusta W. Riemer, nee Schmidt, was born March 5, 1859, in Prussia, Germany. Here she spent her girlhood. She was married near Berlin to Frank Riemer, the exact date not known. She came with her husband directly from Germany to Groton in the spring of 1886, and has since made her home here. Two daughters were born to the family, Mrs. Anna Yeater, of Hazleton, N. D.; and Mrs. Martha Hunt, of Portland, Oregon. Mrs. Yeater was here for the funeral, but Mrs. Hunt was unable to come.

Mr. Riemer preceded her to the grave many years, having passed away May 12, 1888. At the time of her taking away Mrs. Riemer was 67 years, 7 months and 8 days of age.

Funeral services were held from the Lutheran church yesterday afternoon with interment in Groton Union cemetery.
