Mass of Christian burial for Marian Rix, 47, of Groton, was held Friday, Sept. 26, in the United Methodist Church, Groton. Monsignor Marvin McPhee officiated. Special clergy was the Rev. Emil Eberhart.

She was a member of the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church in Groton, was a member of the Altar Society, was a Continuing Christian Development (CCD) teacher, was a member of PEO, and was a member of a craft club.
