✓ **JOHN HARRISON ROBINSON**

Dies at Aberdeen Hospital After Suffering From Injury.

John Harrison Robinson died at Aberdeen on Monday of last week, to which place he was taken a couple of weeks ago and placed in a hospital to receive treatment for injuries he sustained in a fall some months ago from which he never recovered.

John Robinson was born August 30, 1876, in Kalamazoo county, Michigan and came to South Dakota in the spring of 1883.

Miss Minnie Robinson went to Aberdeen, Tuesday, to make arrangements to have the remains brought to Groton and placed in charge of Undertaker Diedrich.

Funeral services were held at the Robinson home Wednesday afternoon, at 3:00 o'clock, Rev. Harrold, officiating. Interrment was made in the Groton Union cemetery.
