Herman Rock

Services for Herman Frederick Rock, 68, Stratford, were held Wednesday, September 30, at 2 p. m. at the Presbyterian Church in Stratford, with the Rev. Robert Carey of Groton officiating.

Burial was in Riverside Memorial Park in Aberdeen.

The Stratford American Legion was in charge of the military committal.

Mr. Rock was born June 2, 1896 at Groton and had lived all of his life in the Stratford-Groton area. He operated a garage in Stratford, until his retirement two years ago. He was a veteran of World War I and spent 13 months on overseas duty.

He was married to Marian Churchill on July 20, 1923. He was a member of the American Legion, the Warner Masonic Blue Lodge and the Presbyterian Church.
