Ann Roettele, 91, 1217 No. Lloyd, Aberdeen, died Tuesday, May 29 at Aberdeen Living Center.

The funeral was held Saturday, June 2, at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Aberdeen, with Father Jim Friedrich officiating. Burial followed at the Groton Union Cemetery under the direction of Miller-Huebl Funeral Home.
