Lorine Rosenow, 89, Groton, died Friday, Nov. 12, 2004 at Avera St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen.

Her funeral was Monday, Nov. 15, 2004 at St. John's Lutheran Church, Groton, with the Rev. Craig Grams officiating. Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Aberdeen, with Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton, in charge of arrangements.

Lorine Lucille Thurston was born December 14, 1914 to Arthur and Cora (Stauffenberg) Thurston, Plana, SD. Lorine attended Wagner Grade School, near Putney, and graduated from Groton High School in 1933. After graduation, she worked at Miller's Merchandise Store, Groton.
