Funeral services for Harold E. Samuel, Groton, were held at 10 a.m. Friday, Aug. 22, at the Groton Church in Groton with the Rev. Robert Carey officiating. Burial was in the Memorial Park Cemetery in Aberdeen with military honors at the graveside by the American Legion.

Samuel died August 19 at Groton Hospital in Aberdeen following a long illness.
