The funeral services for Anna A. Schlichting, 83, of Bethesda Home of Aberdeen were held at 2 p.m., Tuesday, Feb. 25, with the Rev. James Reeb officiating.

Burial was in East Rondell Cemetery at Stratford.

She died Sunday, Feb. 23, 1986, at St. Luke's Hospital.
