- The funeral for Anna D. Schlosser, 77, of Aberdeen and formerly of Frederick was held Saturday, February 8, 2003 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Frederick. The Rev. Galen Sylvester officiated.

- She was united in marriage to Harold Schlosser on June 24, 1954 at Aberdeen. They made their home on a farm near Frederick. They farmed there until the mid 1950's when they relocated to Lewiston, Idaho. After a short time, they returned to the Frederick area and resumed farming. In December of 1992, her husband died.
