Larry A. Schmaal, 47, Groton, died at St. Luke's Midland Regional Medical Center Wednesday, Sept. 18.

The funeral was held at the Miller-Huebl Funeral Home Monday with the Rev. Raymond Pomplun officiating. Burial followed at the Wayside Cemetery, Frederick.

A family prayer service was held Sunday at the funeral home.

Larry Arthur Schmaal was born at Huron on January 21, 1944, to Arthur William and Elda Emilia (Schlosser) Schmaal. The family lived at Wolsey where he started school. The family moved to the Junction City, Ore., area in 1956. He married MaDonna Craig at Harrisburg, Ore., on December 1, 1962, and they made their home in Junction City.
