Services for Albert A. Schmidt, 70 Langford, were held Wednesday at 2 p. m., in the Langford Lutheran Church. Mr. Schmidt died Saturday at St. Luke's Hospital in Aberdeen.

The Rev. George Thompson officiated. Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens in Aberdeen.

In 1902 he came to the Groton area with his parents where he grew up. On June 6, 1918 he was united in marriage to Elbertha Lois Taylor at Dodge Center, Iowa. They farmed in the Groton community until 1937 when they moved to the Langford-Andover area where they continued to farm until 1955 when they moved to a small farm east of Langford. Since 1955 he spent his retirement gardening and raising flowers.

He was a member of Langford Lutheran Church and Corinthian Lodge No. 82 A.F. & A. M. of Andover.
