Services for Arthur J. Schuelke, 78, were held Tuesday, Feb. 10, at 2 p. m., at St. John Lutheran Church. The Rev. Russell Peterson officiating. Burial was in the Groton cemetery.

Mr. Schuelke passed away early Sunday morning, Feb. 8, en route to St. Luke's Hospital, having been in ill health since suffering a heart attack on December 19.

Music was provided by the congregation singing hymns, "My Hope Is Built On Nothing Less;" "I Know My Redeemer Lives," and "For All the Saints," accompanied by Mrs. Eugene Neuman, organist.

Mr. Schuelke, a retired farmer, was a resident of the Groton community all his life. He was a life-long member of St. John Lutheran Church where he had served as congregation chairman, elder and trustee.

Survivors include his widow; four sons, Ora and Robert, both of Groton; Lyle, Huron, and Allen, Stockton, Calif. and one daughter, Mrs. Daryl (Ardis) Danielson, West Fargo, N. D.; one sister, Miss Augusta Schuelke, Aberdeen; 17 grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one daughter, one brother and three sisters.
