Funeral services for Mrs. Arthur (Mathilda) Schuelke, 82, Groton, were held Friday, May 25, at 2 p.m. at St. John's Lutheran Church. The Rev. Russell Peterson officiated. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.
