Robert Schuller

Services for Robert D. Schuller, were held Thursday afternoon, Feb. 4 at the Claremont Methodist Church. Mr. Schuller, 51, died at the Britton Memorial Hos-

pital. Preston Brown officiated. Burial was in the Groton cemetery. Officiating ministers were LaVern Swanson, James Perkins, Kenneth Frey, Gerald and Wayne and Keith Cutler. Music was provided by the church choir. They sang, "Faith of Our Fathers" and "The Lord Is My Shepherd," coordinated by Mrs. Mabel Pierson.

Schuller was born Oct. 3, 1913, in Claremont. He was married to Edna Wigdahl in Langford, June 1941. He was a member of the Claremont Methodist Church, had served as chairman of the church board and treasurer of the building fund. He also served as township clerk for several years.
