Clarice J. Schumacher, 80, of Aberdeen, died Friday, March 7, 2003, at Avera St. Luke's Hospital. Her funeral service will be 11:00 a.m., Thursday, March 13th at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, 1429 North Dakota St., Aberdeen with Rev. Roger Noer officiating. Burial will follow at Sunset Memorial Gardens, Aberdeen.



Visitation will be 2-8 p.m. Wednesday at Miller-Huebl Funeral Home, 1111 S. Main St., Aberdeen and one hour prior to the service at the church Thursday.

Clarice J. Dahl was born April 29, 1922 at Claremont, SD to Edwin and Alice (Ewart) Dahl. This is the area where she attended school, graduating from Claremont High School with the Class of 1940. Her father operated the Cargill Elevator, where she and her sister worked. This work groomed her for her job with the A.A.A. which later became the A.S.C.S. Office, where she served as program coordinator for thirty years.

On May 4, 1946 she married Warren H. Schumacher of Bowdle, SD. They made their home in Aberdeen. On December 31, 1974 she retired from the A.S.C.S. Office. Warren died on May 22, 1995 and Clarice continued to make Aberdeen her home until the time of her death.

She was a member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, the E.L.C.W., National Association of Retired Federal Employees, O.E.S. Minerva Chapter #5, the Shrine Auxiliary and the A.A.R.P.
