John F. Seck, 80, former Andover and Webster resident, passed away Saturday, June 6, at the Community Hospital, Santa Ana, Calif., after an extended illness. He has been a patient of the Royale Convalescence Hospital in Santa Ana the past three years.

A rosary service was held Monday evening and the funeral mass on June 9 at St. Anne's Catholic Church in Santa Ana.

Mass was offered Thursday morning at 10:30 a. m., in All Saints Catholic Church, Andover, with Father McPhee officiating. Interment was in the church cemetery.

Pall bearers were Herman Czmowski, Roman Czmowski, Raymond Sass, all of Webster, Anton Schwab, Edward and Eugene Prunty, all of Andover.

Mr. Seck was born in North Judson, Ind., April 18, 1890, to Wm. and Cecelia Szczeck who migrated to the United States from Poland. Mr. Seck came to the Andover-Groton vicinity in 1918 where he farmed until moving to Webster in 1944, and then moved to California in 1953, where they have since resided. On Sept. 23, 1924, he was married to Beatrice Prunty Beumer.

Survivors are his wife, one son, six daughters, twenty-four grandchildren, three great grandchildren and one brother.
