## Jacob Wesmer Seth ✓

Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock from the Paetznick Funeral Home for Jacob Wesmer Seth, 72, who passed away Tuesday, Feb. 26, at St. Luke's hospital in Aberdeen. The Rev. L. C. Benson officiated. Misses Myrtle and Margaret Blader sang several hymns, accompanied by Mrs. F. G. MacKenzie on the piano. Burial was in the Groton cemetery.
