Jake Seth Dies; ✓ Funeral Held Tuesday

Mrs. Jake Seth, who has made her home in Groton since 1922, died in an illness Saturday evening. A funeral was held from the home Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, officiated by Rev. L. C. Bennett. The remains were laid to rest in Groton cemetery.

Mrs. Seth was born at McCloud, N. D., Feb. 14, 1890. In 1915 she moved to Seward, Neb., and in 1918 she married Mr. Seth, with whom she were born to this family.
