The funeral for Leona Siek, 91, Groton, will be held at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at St. John's Lutheran Church in Groton. The Rev. Craig Grams will officiate.

Burial will be in Sunset Memorial Gardens at Aberdeen with Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel in Groton in charge of arrangements.

A prayer service was held Wednesday evening at the funeral chapel.

Visitation was from 1 to 9 p.m. Wednesday at the funeral chapel, and prior to the service Thursday at the church.

She died Monday, Oct. 28, 1996, at St. Luke's Midland Regional Medical Center in Aberdeen.

Leona Stange was born July 25, 1905, to John and Emilie (Maske) Stange in Lomira, Wis. Her family moved to the Groton area when she was five months old. They lived on a farm five miles southwest of Groton. She was baptized on August 13, 1905, in Lomira. She was confirmed June 1, 1919, at St. John's Lutheran Church in West Hanson Township.

She married Edmund Siek on October 19, 1940. They lived on a farm near Stratford. She was a member of West Hanson Church where she taught Sunday school for many years. After he died in 1960, she moved to Groton and at that time became a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Groton. She was a member of the Ladies Aide and the Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML). She was also a



member of the Groton Senior Citizens. She became a resident of Colonial Manor in Groton in November 1994.

Survivors include three sisters, Mrs. Mary Neuman, Mrs. Emil (Lillian) Rose, and Elda Stange, all of Groton; and numerous nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her husband, three sisters and two brothers.
