## Orylin Sippel

The funeral services for Orylin Sippel, 54, Pierpont, were held at 2 p.m., Saturday, Nov. 21, at the Presbyterian Church in Groton with the Rev. Bob Roth and the Rev. Leslie Hernes officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery. The Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel was in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Sippel died Wednesday, Nov. 18 at his home near Pierpont in Independence Township.
