Dale Sour, 78, Groton, died March 23 at the Colonial Manor, Groton.

The funeral was held Tuesday at the United Methodist Church, Groton, with the Rev. Dean Trapp officiating.

His cremated remains will be buried in the Groton Union Cemetery at a later date, under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton.

Dale Sour was born December 4, 1912, to Byron and Hazel Sibert Sour at Hayti, S.D. He grew up in Hayti and graduated from Hayti High School. He and his brother, Harold, had a cafe in Hayti.

He married Janet Bowles at Groton June 17, 1936. They moved to Groton in 1937 where he became part owner of Bowles & Sour Ford, which was later renamed Pioneer Ford under his ownership. He also farmed in the area.
