Mrs. Emma Stange

Services for Mrs. Emma Stange, 91, were held Sunday, Jan. 24th, 1960, in St. John's Lutheran church in Groton. The Rev. W. J. Link of Aberdeen conducted the service.

Mrs. Stange died Thursday, Jan. 21. She was born Dec. 22, 1868, in Dodge County, Wisconsin. She was the daughter of Christ and Sophia Klei-foth, and was united in marriage to William Stange, March 9, 1886, at Theresa, Wis., who preceded her in death, March 6th, 1958. She had been a resident of Stratford and Groton area since 1886. But during late years she lived with her children. She was a member of St. John's Lutheran church of Groton.

Mrs. Stange is survived by six children, Edwin of Wheaton, Minn.; Paul of Aberdeen; Herman and Mrs. Albert (Erna) Lorenz of Groton, and Mrs. Alex (Helena) Schley and Ewald of Stratford; also 26 grandchildren, 36 great grandchildren and 2 great-great grandchildren.
