Herman A. Stange

Services for Herman A. Stange, 68, retired farmer, were held Saturday afternoon, Feb. 3, at St. John Lutheran Church. Mr. Stange died Wednesday, January 31.

The Rev. Gordon Buchholz and the Rev. Harry Kriefall officiated and burial was at Sunset Memorial Gardens, Aberdeen.
