Oscar R. Stange

Services for Oscar R. Stange, 75, long-time farmer of the Stratford and Columbia areas, was held at 2 p. m., Wednesday, May 3 at the First Baptist Church in Aberdeen with the Rev. Harold E. Salem officiating.

Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens cemetery.

Mr. Stange died at his farm home Friday evening.

He was born Sept. 2, 1891, in Rondell Township, Brown County. As a small child, he lived with his family in Stratford for several years. Later the family moved to Groton, where he attended grade school. Later the family returned to the Stratford area.

He married Anna Hult at Prentice, Wis., on Sept. 25, 1921. They farmed in the Stratford area until 18 years ago, when they moved to their present farm northeast of Columbia. Mr. Stange had been in ill health since suffering a heart attack last Christmas.

Survivors besides his widow are one son, Robert, rural Columbia; four brothers, Fred, of Los Angeles; Theodore of Spokane, Wash., and Gerhardt and Arthur, both of Pontiac, Mich., and one sister, Mrs. Esther Winit, Los Angeles.

Three brothers preceded him in death.
