The funeral for Mrs. Henry (Elizabeth) Sundermeyer, 91, Andover, was held at 2 p.m., Monday at Zion Lutheran Church in Andover with the Rev. Larry I. Geyer officiating.

Burial was in the Andover Cemetery. The Paetznick - Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton, was in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Sundermeyer died Thursday, Oct. 21, at the Day County Hospital in Webster.

Survivors include one son, William, Andover; one daughter, Mrs. Peter (Florence) Dauwen, Milbank; six grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband and four sisters.
