The funeral for Twila Lynnae Swanson, 38, Groton and formerly of Mobridge, was held Wednesday, May 16, 1990 in Trinity Lutheran Church, Mobridge. The Reverend E. Douglas Heskin and the Reverend Roger Noer, Aberdeen, conducted the service. Burial was in Greenwood Cemetery at Mobridge.

She died Saturday, May 12 at St. Luke's Medical Center in Aberdeen after a three year illness with cancer.

Twila Fuhrer was born October 4, 1951 at Isabel to Gilbert and Elaine (Miller) Fuhrer. She spent her early years at Isabel and attended two years of grade school there. In 1960 she moved with her parents to Mobridge, and attended school there, graduating from Mobridge High School in 1969. She then moved to Aberdeen where she attended and graduated from the Aberdeen School of Commerce. She married John Swanson February 19, 1972 at Mobridge. The couple lived in Aberdeen for a short time before returning to Mobridge. While in Mobridge, she was employed in the office of the

Mobridge Hospital for eight years until May 1989. Since then she has been in failing health. In 1989, they moved to Groton where she lived the remainder of her life. She was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church in Mobridge.

She is survived by her husband, John Swanson; one daughter, Danika, 11; and one son, Landon, 8, all of Groton; her parents, Gilbert and Elaine Fuhrer, Mobridge; one sister, Mrs. Ken (Sheryl) Keller, and one brother, Mark Fuhrer, both of Mobridge. She was preceded in death by both her paternal and maternal grandparents.
