### ROBERT SWINSON

A pioneer resident of this locality passed away in far off Oklahoma when Robert Swinson responded to the final summons last week. Deceased was about fifty-two years of age. He moved his family to Oklahoma about six years ago, largely on account of the failing health of his wife. Attacked with fatal diabetes he was the first to go, and Mrs. Swinson brought his body home to Groton for interment.

Mr. Swinson was in all ways a good citizen, and his death is sincerely mourned by old time neighbors and friends.

Mrs. A. H. Potter, sister of Mrs. Swinson, went to Oklahoma when Mr. Swinson's illness became serious, and accompanied the widow and the body back to Groton.

Besides the bereaved wife, Mr. Swinson is survived by four children.

The body reached Groton last evening, and burial services will occur this afternoon.
