Mrs. Caroline Taylor, 85, former Conde resident, died Wednesday, Dec. 27, at the Colonial Manor in Groton.

Services were held Saturday, Dec. 30, at the Conde Methodist Church with the Rev. James Persons officiating.

Mrs. Melvin Rossow was the organist and the church choir sang.
