Robert L. Taylor

Services for Robert L. Taylor, 64, Conde, were held Tuesday, May 21, at 2:30 p.m. at the Conde High School gym with the Rev. Richard Gould officiating. Burial was in the Conde Cemetery with Masonic graveside services.

Mr. Taylor died May 17 at Dakota Midland Hospital in Aberdeen.

The church choir sang, "Beyond the Sunset" and "I Need You Every Hour," accompanied by Mrs. Melvin Rossow, organist.

Honorary pallbearers were all Masonic brothers. Active pallbearers were Rollie Fey, Marvin Hausvik, Marlon Jensen, Howard Nogle, Elmer Shoop and Frank Washnok.

Mr. Taylor was born June 18, 1909, at Conde. He married Eldwin Chaon on Oct. 3, 1941, at Conde. He was a lifetime farmer in the Conde area. He was a member of the Methodist Church, the Masonic Lodge and Shrine bodies and was past president of the Conde Civic Development Assn. He served as mayor and city councilman for several years and served on the Conde township board. He was a past PTA president.

Survivors include his widow; his mother, Mrs. Sylvia Taylor, Bristol; two sons, Arvon of Conde and Aaron of Sioux Falls; one daughter, Mrs. Jim (Mary) Gederos, Aberdeen; four brothers, Ben of Conde, Dale of Marcus, Iowa, and Frank and Howard, both of Los Angeles, Calif.; two sisters, Mrs. Ethel Schwartz and Mrs. Clarence (Maxine) Biersbach, Bristol; and four grandchildren.
