The five year old son of Mr. and Mrs. J. M. Teasdale, died on Friday last at the home of its grandfather, A. D. Mower. Mrs. Teasdale and children came here for a visit from Lancaster, Wis., about two weeks ago. The little boy was stricken with membranous croup on Tuesday of last week, and was sick for only a little more than three days. Mr. Teasdale who is traveling from Escanaba, Mich. for the International Harvester Co., was located by wire and came at once, reaching Doland Sunday morning and drove to Groton. Funeral services were held on Monday afternoon from the Mower home, and the body was buried in Union cemetery. The child was born in Groton in 1901, and was the victim of a bad siege of sickness the same year. For days he lingered between life and death, but finally pulled through.
