## Clarence W. Tewksbury

Clarence W. Tewksbury, retired farmer and Ferney area resident since 1928, died Wednesday at the Day County Hospital in Webster. He was 80 years old.

Funeral services were held at 2:00 p. m., Friday, June 16 at the Groton Methodist Church with the Rev. K. Oliver Brekke officiating with interment in the local cemetery.
