CARL J. TOLLEFSON

Carl J. Tollefson, 77, of Aberdeen, died Sunday morning at St. Luke's hospital, after a long illness. Funeral services were held at 2:00 p. m., Wednesday at Bethlehem Lutheran church in Aberdeen, with the Rev. A. Elmer Moe officiating.

Mr. Tollefson was born on Sept. 27, 1874, at Fairfax, Minn., and grew up there. On Nov. 18, 1901, he was married to Nellie Maxwell there. They moved to Stratford in 1907 where Mr. Tollefson was in the grain buying business. In 1943 they moved to Aberdeen. Mr. Tollefson was a member of the Bethlehem Lutheran church, the Masonic lodge at Stratford, and of the Scottish Rite and the Shrine in Aberdeen.

Survivors are his wife; one daughter, Mrs. Fabian Deschner, Prospect Heights, Ill.; two sons, Louis of Aberdeen, and Gordon, of Billings, Mont.; one sister, Mrs. Wm. Schwartz, Hector, Minn.; a brother, Julius Tollefson, Stewart, Minn., and three grandchildren. One son, Eldon, died in 1949.
