### Mrs. Jack Torguson

Funeral services for Mrs. Jack Torguson were held at the Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Pierpont, on Tuesday, April 10, at 2 P. M. The Pastor, Rev. L. V. Syta and Rev. George Undem of Viborg, South Dakota officiated. During the services Wally Loe of Pierpont sang "The Old Rugged Cross" and "Den Store Hvide Flak". Mrs. Robert Franzen was the accompanist. Della Hansine Fuglesten was born in Stavanger, Norway on March 11, 1900. She was baptized in the Jelsa Church in Norway. At the age of six weeks, she, her parents, Daniel and Helga Fuglesten and sisters came to America where they settled at Enderlin, North Dakota. In 1908 they moved and homesteaded near Hettinger, North Dakota, where she grew to womanhood. She was confirmed in the Immanuel Lutheran Church on October 23, 1914. She was united in marriage to John A. Torguson at St. Marieh, Idaho at the Lutheran Parsonage on October 7, 1919. They spent the early years of their marriage in the area around Hettinger. In the summer of 1925 they moved to South Dakota in the vicinity of Pierpont where she spent her remaining life. This union was blessed by three children, Joyce (Mrs. F. W. Overmier), Duane and James.

She was an active member of the Ladies Aid and Darcas Circle of the Bethlehem Church of Pierpont. She contributed pleasure to those around her by her warm and friendly personality.

She was preceded in death by her father, mother and two brothers.
