Dora Tremi

The funeral for Dora A. Tremi, 91, former Groton resident, was held at 10 a.m., Wednesday, Nov. 17, at St. John's Catholic Church in Groton with the Rev. Leonard Fox officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Catholic Cemetery. The Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel of Groton was in charge of arrangements.

Mrs. Tremi died Sunday, Nov. 14, at the Inver Grove Heights Care Center at St. Paul, Minn.

Survivors include one son, George, Groton; one brother, John Schott, Bellflower, Calif.; one sister, Mrs. Louise Patterson, Cedar Falls; three grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband, one daughter, one brother and two sisters.
