

Leo Udelhofen *i-22-8*

The funeral services for Leo F. Udelhofen, 87, of Groton, were held on Tuesday, Jan. 21, at 2 p.m. in St. John's Lutheran Church in Groton with the Rev. Dan Elkins officiating. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel.

Mr. Udelhofen died at Dakota Midland Hospital January 18, 1986.
