F. B. UDELL DIES.

The Pierpont Signal of Thursday contained the following:

"We are in receipt of the sad news from Aberdeen that F. B. Udell departed from this life this forenoon at 104.5. The remains will be brought here tomorrow morning and the funeral will be held at 3:0 Saturday afternoon."

It is recalled that deceased was the victim of a very serious fire at his home five weeks ago.

Forest Udell lived on a farm north of Groton in the early days, and was married to Miss Laura Willits, whose home was also here. Beside the widow, a son and daughter survive him, Britton Udell of the Aberdeen post-office, and Miss Lucile Udell, who teaches at present at Stillwater, Minn.

Mr. Udell had been postmaster at Pierpont for many years. Old friends in this locality deeply sympathize with the stricken family.
